GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- **ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUESTED TO CAREFULLY STUDY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF RESPECTIVE EVENTS**

- ❖ **Only Students who have completed the registration are allowed to participate.**

- ❖ **Entry Limit per Participant :**
 - **Off Stage Events - No Limit**
 - **Individual Events - 4**
 - **Group Events – 4**

- ❖ **Entry Limit per House :**
 - **Off Stage Individual Events - 10**
 - **Off Stage Group Events - 2**
 - **Individual Events - 2**
 - **Group Events – 1**

- ❖ **If any participant is found to be participating in more than 4 on-stage events, either individual or group events (Adzap is an exception), all the events in which the participant is involved will be disqualified without any consideration.**

- ❖ **If any house attempts to enter more than 10 participants for any off-stage event, all entries from that house for that particular event will be disqualified, and no participant from that house will be allowed to compete in that event.**

- ❖ **Online entries and Spot registrations will not be allowed in any case.**
 - ❖ **Group Events maybe registered in the name of the Group Leader.**
 - ❖ **However, a complete list of the participants must be produced 1 week before the event.**
 - ❖ **All participants must report to the Committee Members at least 30 Minutes before the commencement of the event**
 - ❖ **Only USB devices are allowed for audio. CDs, Mobile phones, etc. are not accepted. Participants are requested to carry backup of the media files to avoid technical delays. We also request the participants or group members to do proper audio check before the event.**

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

- No appeals will be entertained for any event.
- Video recording of all on-stage events must be done by the respective group members. In case of any discrepancies, the recorded video will be requested for verification.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule for the smooth conduct of the events. Any changes will be duly notified.
- For on-stage events, a warning bell will be rung 1 minute before the specified time limit. At the end of the allotted time, the final bell will ring. However, grace time of 30 seconds will be provided for all events, irrespective of the time limit. If the performance exceeds the grace time, the participant/team will be disqualified.
- In case of any complaints, before the commencement of the programme or after the announcement of results, participants are not permitted to communicate directly with judges or cause any form of disturbance. All concerns must be conveyed only through stage volunteers, coordinators, or by directly contacting the organizers available at the time.
- All complaints must be reported within 1 hour of the completion of the respective event
